# Characteristics of creative people:



## x Intelligence:

Creative people are always smart enough. That is, people with high intelligence are not necessarily creative people. Rather, they are creative people who have been able to train and organize their intelligence in a desirable way.

## x Fluid thinking:

Has the ability to quickly create a large number of ideas.



## x Perceptual flexibility:

They have the ability to break a rule and a framework and find new frameworks. In other words, their minds can better and faster break down molds and achieve new patterns.

## x innovation:

Have the ability and desire to generate unusual and conventional responses in response to environmental stimuli. Diversity and aversion to doing things routinely are other features of this feature.





X Independence of opinion and arbitration:

Other characteristics of these people are self-reliance and measuring thoughts and ideas based on logic and reasoning, away from dependencies and riots and unwillingness to be in harmony with the community.

X Self Confidence:

They believe in their ability and have a realistic picture of their capabilities and limits of their abilities.

X Risk:


They are not afraid of criticism and failure and see mistakes as opportunities to learn.



- Mental focus:

They actively and diligently come up with ideas, both mentally and practically.





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X Knowledge:

Creative people spend many years gaining knowledge and mastery of their favorite subject, and in addition, they are constantly developing their knowledge and awareness.

X historical background:

Creative people have generally had a variety of events in their lives, and sometimes they have had great losses such as parents or financial resources. These deficiencies generally evoke a sense of need and force the individual to think of creative solutions to meet their needs.

## X Need to succeed:

Creative people need to be successful in achieving their goals. This need is a strong and encouraging resource for the individual to redouble his efforts to reach new solutions, take more risks and focus more strongly on the issue.

Creativity involves the production of something that is both original and valuable and originates from the conscious and unconscious processes of man. From a scientific point of view, the products of creative thinking are sometimes referred to as divergent thinking. As with other phenomena, there is no single view or definition of creativity in science, and it is variously attributed to the following: cognitive process, social environment, personal characteristics, luck, as well as things like genius, mental illness, and humor.





**Ways to cultivate creativity depend on the following three factors**



# Experience:

It is the richest source of fuel and the factor that enables human beings to come up with creative ideas. Experience can be gained from doing various and risky tasks, traveling especially in difficult and tragic conditions and to remote places, personal contacts with others, especially children, reading people's biographies, watching TV, listening to the radio, etc.





# Brain games:

Solving puzzles, tables, chess, crossword puzzles, twenty questions, playing in the open air, solving math problems, especially geometry and probability problems, which are a kind of mental exercise, are effective in strengthening the power of thinking.





# Great effort:

What motivates creativity is not necessarily extraordinary intelligence and genius, but the extra effort that creative people put into making the brain imagine. Hard work and getting used to our work and effort helps us to generate creative ideas.





# Knowledge:

The emergence of new ideas requires a lot of knowledge. In fact, knowledge is the raw material of imagination. The constant development of knowledge and vast information play an irreplaceable role in the emergence of creative ideas.



# Questioning spirit:

Strengthening the spirit of questioning and the fact that man is not afraid to ask seemingly childish questions and ask challenging questions, fosters curiosity in man and accelerates the deconstruction of mental patterns.
